Milk recorders visit farms on a regular basis to take samples, deliver to the laboratory and return results by post or electronically.

CIS Milk Recording Leads

In recent weeks the way we display animals Johnes Testing results has seen a small change, in-line with the wider industry we are now showing animals which have had two consecutive positive results as 'red' A5 cows for life, regardless of any future results they may have. The basis for this is to help identify those animals which pose the greatest risk to the herd and aid with any decision making around Johnes Control Strategies. We are also pleased to say that our Vet Advisers at CIS who review and provide comments on the Johnes report for your herd were amongst the first cohort to pass the BCVA Johnes Accreditation - gaining the status of "BCVA Accredited Johnes Veterinary Adviser" or BAJVA for short. Well done to Dan and Mark of XLVets.

Awards such as the Lifetime Production, the Superior Performer and Star Brood Cow Awards can be presented automatically to CIS milk recording customers who register with Holstein UK.

The Superior Performer (SP) and Lifetime Producer (LP) Lifetime Production Awards are issued automatically to those herds which join the scheme. When Holstein UK receives the completed 305-day lactations from CIS, they are checked for eligibility and the awards are made accordingly.
