



A Guide to recording Mobility Monitoring Scores with YourHerd


Step 1: Log into YourHerd, our free online heard management programme, from the CIS homepage www.thecis.co.uk

Step 5: Enter the date of the new scores or select an existing set of scores, along with making a note of who scored on that day if required.

If you select existing scores it will copy your last set of scores

Your Herd - Record Mobility step 1 of 2 - Enter the date the measurements were taken

Select an existing set of measurements 

or enter the date for a new set of measurements  e.g. 01 Jan 2003

and the name of the person doing the new measurements

Step 6: 'Enter your Animals Mobility Scores'. There is the option to enter scores for just the milking herd, youngstock or all animals. Animals can be ordered in line number or ear tag order. There is a tick box to select high priority animals as well as a box to add any comments such as history, treatment or actions.



Top Tips:

1. It is useful to click on the blue arrows at the bottom of the page and select 'All Rows' before you start.
2. Clicking on red text will auto fill the score as 0 for every animal.

Click on the animals ear tag number to access the individual Mobility Score history for that individual.

Step 7: Click on 'Run Report' at the bottom of the page to get a printable report for all animals. This report can be ranked by Priority, Mobility Score, Ear Tag, Age or Line No. This report will also show any comments that were added.



A 'Herd Mobility Trend Graph' will then be displayed for each time the herd has been scored – showing how the trend for the herd has changed over time. This will build up the more you use it.

Top Tip
 Hover the mouse over the bars within the chart to provide a breakdown of the data within it.

Recorder Sheets

A 'Recorders Sheet' can be used to note down the mobility scores. The scores can then be entered on to YourHerd either by the customer or the milk recorder can enter them at the next visit.

To obtain the Recorder Sheet - from the Main Menu, click on the 'Reports Menu' then on the 'Recorder Sheet' option, press run report to get the printable list.



